All that kids can be

- > Bus tickets for 1 youth to get to and from school for 1 week
- > A nutritious snack for 30 immigrant youth during their After School Program
- > Allows 1 youth with a disability to attend a week of I.C.A.N.! camps

Healthy people, strong communities

- > 1 hour of positive parenting consultation for new parents
- > 1 hour of phone counselling support from the Women's Emergency Shelter

From poverty to possibility

- > Lunch for 17 working homeless people
- > 1 month of telephone, internet and fax services for a recent immigrant woman transitioning into affordable housing

\$120

All that kids can be

- > 1 elementary school start up package (including shoes, back pack, calculator, etc.) for a child in need
- > Education for 1 youth for 1 year
- > 2 months of supplies for a school support program

Healthy people, strong communities

- > Childcare for 5 immigrant women
- > 2 hours of counselling for a child, youth or family
- > 2 new parent networking sessions

From poverty to possibility

- > 1 weeks worth of groceries for a family of 4
- > 4 months of lunches for a working homeless person
- > 1 full set of ID for 2 youth (birth certificate, SIN, picture ID) needed for employment

\$365

All that kids can be

- > 1 week of summer day camp for 3 children or youth
- > Weekly counselling for 1 youth for 1 year
- > Two weeks of on-going one to one support, mentorship and advocacy for a youth in crisis

Healthy people, strong communities

- > 3 nights of emergency accommodation for an individual experiencing personal disaster
- > 1.5 days of emergency child care for a single parent family in crisis

From poverty to possibility

- > A monthly delivery of fresh fruit and vegetables to a small family for 1 year
- > 6 hours of personal employment counselling and resume building
- > Warm winter clothing for a family of 4

\$1,000

All that kids can be

- > 500 breakfasts for children
- > 1 year of early childhood programs for one immigrant child
- > Transportation for 2 youth to attend school for 1 year

Healthy people, strong communities

- > 14 weeks in a victim support group for 1 female
- > Complete lawn care and snow removal for 1 senior for 1 year
- > 4 sessions of group therapy for abusive men

From poverty to possibility

- > 3 months of rental subsidization for 1 senior living in poverty
- > Access to transportation and groceries for a small family for 1 month
- > Assists a family in moving into affordable accommodation, preventing homelessness
