Key Duties & Responsibilities:

- Strategy Implementation- Ensure the effective implementation of the investment strategy including the development of a plan that focuses on building partnerships and facilitating collective contributions to address the identified social issues that underlie the Investment Strategy
- Support the alignment and integration of the All In for Youth Initiative with other children and youth investments
- Organizational expertise and leadership – Provide organizational leadership in addressing issues related to children, youth and families
- Sector/Strategic Relationships - Be a primary link to community groups and systems to address existing and emerging social issues related to families, children and youth
- Community Leadership - Provide leadership or key linkages to the implementation of strategic community initiatives that align with the Strategy
- Leadership and responsibility of internal projects related to children, youth and families
- Leverage Impact - Provide recommendations regarding investments, engagement, policies, and systemic issues in order to create more impact on key areas of the Strategy
- Financial Oversight - Facilitate, manage, and coordinate financial resources to key areas of the Strategy.

- At least 5 years' relevant experience working in a leadership position related to children, youth and families service delivery
- At least 3 years' relevant experience in strategic leadership, experience in change management and experience in building partnerships to impact social change

- Budgeting and financial management skills
- Proven ability to work collaboratively with groups of multiple stakeholders from different sectors
